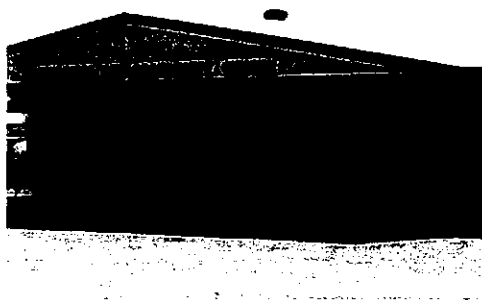

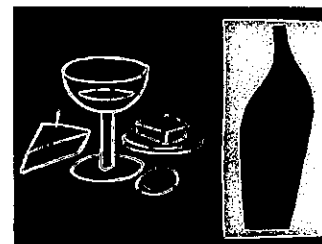

Hardwicke Bay Water Supply Scheme update.

The Association have written to Yorke Peninsula Council requesting further information about the original agreement between the residents and Council as to 'future maintenance costs and projections...why the water management of the 3 townships is being combined along with the annual charges to ratepayers'. Given the Council business is drawing to a close for the holidays, and due to the downtime because of the elections, we are not expecting further news on the matter until the new year.

In response to our request to Council to support the Association's initiative for the upgrading of the Beach Road Entrance and proposed slipway from the Minlaton to Warooka Road, we have been advised 'the matter will be addressed by the new Council in the near future'. We will be following up with this too, post Xmas.

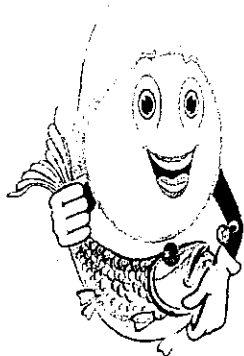

**Easy Chocolate Cake**

- 1 & 1/2 cups hot water
- 250 gms butter
- 200 gms dark cooking chocolate
- 1/4 cup cocoa powder
- 2 cups castor sugar
- 2 eggs lightly beaten
- 2 tsp vanilla essence
- 1 & 1/2 cups SR Flour.

**Method:**

1. In saucepan melt butter, cocoa, chocolate, sugar, vanilla and hot water.
2. When cooled add flour +eggs mix well
3. Pour into lined 30cm cake tin and cook on 150C for 1 hour and 15 minutes.
4. When cool, sprinkle with icing sugar and serve, alone or with cream or ice cream.

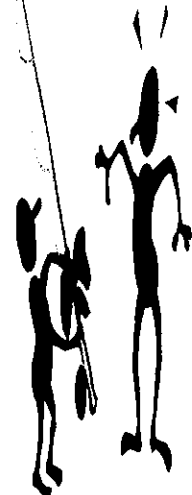

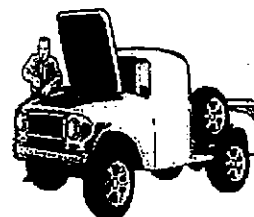

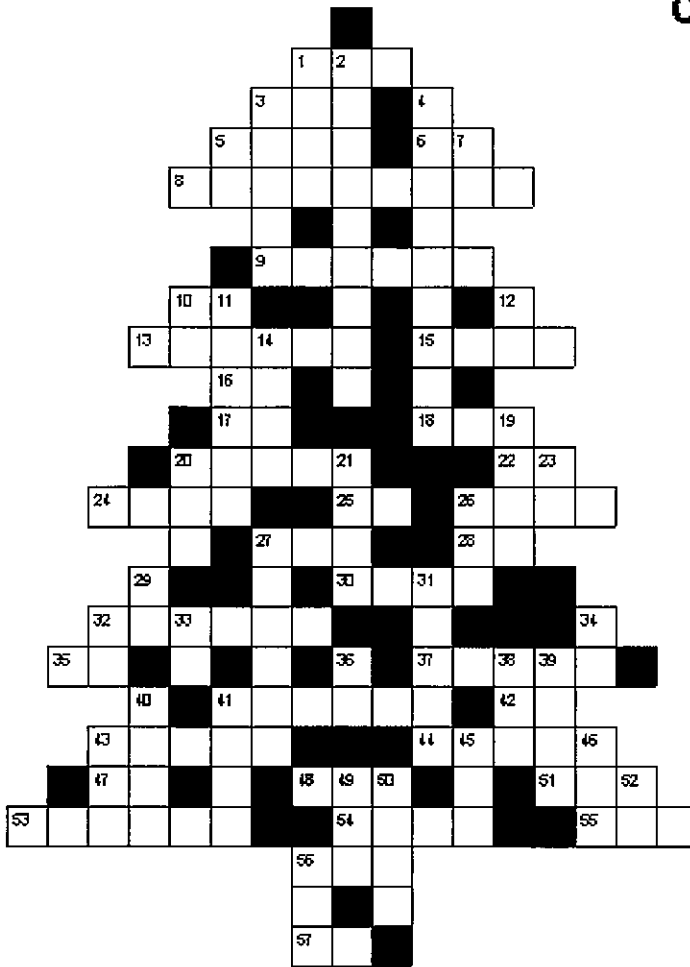
